It involves a mix up on the NT2 manuscript. KIV chapters 17 and 18 of Revelation were originally written down as "correct" on the NT2 manuscript. However, at one point verse 17 of chapter 18 was marked for change. The word "is" was also circled on that verse and then the word "are" was written on NT2 after the words "verse 17th" and the word "corrrect" was crossed out. However, because this change was made after the initial writing, the scribe accidentally wrote the "verse 17th are" correction next to Chapter 17 of Revelation instead of Chapter 18. The chapter numbers utilized Roman numerals and it would be easy to mix up VII for VIII. In addition, verse 17 of Chapter 17 has nothing marked on it for change on the KJV Bible. It is only on verse 17 of Chapter 18. Also, this is not the only incidence where a mix up like this occurred.
