

GOSPEL AND MESSIAH HARMONIES

The purpose of this Harmony of the Gospels is to align the familiar events and teachings in Christ's life in a realistic order - the Gospels do not contain enough information to give a definitive order. It is not intended to cross-reference all of His teachings. Christ taught the Sermon on the Mount, for example, many times in different settings to different people, and when the record mentions He taught, but does not mention content, it was often because what He taught was recorded elsewhere. Therefore not every instance of a teaching is referenced below, nor can similar descriptions of incidents necessarily be assumed to be different versions of the same event. These are left to the reader to discover.



The Law of Moses pointed to Jesus as the Messiah. An effort has been made to identify some of the incidents in Christ's life that fulfill the symbols in the Law of Moses and the Prophets (see Luke 14:3,7; John 2:3; TSJ 2:4; Msh 8:2). This Messiah Harmony references other works against the Gospels. References that point to Moses' example (Deut 6:4) use a superscript ^M.

PRINTING INSTRUCTIONS TO FIT THE A5 SIZED SCRIPTURES (PAPERBACK AND LEATHER-BOUND)

You need to PRECUT your paper to 8 1/8" x 5 9/16". This is slightly narrower so that the final group will fit flush.

SETTINGS

- Print on both sides - Flip pages on LONG edge
- Print pages: 1 - 19. (This will leave out this set of instructions.)
- Page size: A5
- Paper orientation: LANDSCAPE
- Fit all columns to one page.
- With color printers, you may need to select PRINT IN GRAYSCALE in Printer/Page setup or Advanced Settings to remove the blue from the references. (These are hyperlinks and will take you directly to the online scripture references when you view and click on them from a screen.)

Once printed, you can glue, tape, etc., the pages together and they will fit when inserted in the back of your book.
